Dr. Giridhar Kamath P., Principal, spoke on the importance of conserving nature in our lives and how people can reconnect with nature.







BLOOD DONATION CAMP 2018-2019



Later, pamphlets were circulated among the patients to create awareness regarding the deadly disease.




